# Uniting Strength for a New Journey, Empowering the Future with Green Energy

As the spring sunshine draws near and a new chapter unfolds with the turning of the year, I would like, on behalf of the Global Energy Interconnection Development and Cooperation Organization (GEIDCO), to extend my sincere greetings and best wishes to all our members, global partners, and staff. I would also like to express my heartfelt appreciation to friends from all sectors who have long cared for and supported the development of the Global Energy Interconnection (GEI) initiative.

The year 2025 marks the tenth anniversary of the proposal of the GEI initiative by Chinese President Xi Jinping, and represents a milestone year in the development of GEIDCO. Over the past decade, guided by our mission of advancing the Global Energy Interconnection, we have worked hand in hand with members, partners, and stakeholders worldwide, steadily moving the initiative from vision to action and from concept to practice. The GEI initiative has been incorporated into key international frameworks, including the UN 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, the Paris Agreement on climate change, and global biodiversity conservation, as well as multilateral mechanisms such as the Belt and Road Initiative, China–Arab and China–Africa cooperation, and the Clean Energy Ministerial. For six consecutive years, GEI has been included in policy briefs for the UN High-level Political Forum on Sustainable Development (HLPF), gaining broad recognition and active support from more than 100 countries and relevant stakeholders, and evolving into a global consensus and collective action guiding the world's energy transition and sustainable development.

GEIDCO has been granted consultative status of the UNEP and the UNIDO, observer status with the Convention on Biological Diversity and the UNFCCC Secretariat, and

membership in the African Energy Efficiency Alliance. It serves as the executive agency for the “Regional and Global Energy Interconnection” Initiative under the Clean Energy Ministerial (CEM), leads the Connectivity (Power) Working Group under the Belt and Road Energy Partnership Cooperation Network, and acts as Vice Chair of relevant working groups under the APEC Energy Cooperation Network. In this capacity, GEIDCO has become an important contributor to global governance and international energy cooperation.

## Review of 2025

In 2025, GEIDCO remained committed to building platforms, facilitating cooperation, and creating value for its members. Amid challenges, we seized opportunities, deepened engagement in global governance, and empowered green development through pragmatic actions, injecting strong momentum into global energy transition and sustainable development.

**Forging new breakthroughs through global consensus building.** The 7th Global Energy Interconnection Conference was successfully convened with high quality. Mr. Han Zheng, Vice President of China, attended and delivered a keynote address. More than 50 international organizations, including the United Nations, over 200 enterprises, institutions, and universities, and nearly 1,000 participants from 105 countries gathered at the conference, forming a powerful synergy for green and low-carbon development. GEIDCO also organized events and agenda items on major global governance platforms, including the 30th UN Climate Change Conference (COP30), the UN High-level Political Forum on Sustainable Development, the 7th UN Environment Assembly, the First African Energy Efficiency Conference, and the Clean Energy Ministerial, promoting

the Global Energy Interconnection as a key solution for energy transition and sustainable development.

**Achieving new progress in international energy cooperation.** More than 100 high-level dialogues and exchanges were conducted with the United Nations, ASEAN, the African Union, and government ministries of Singapore, Brazil, South Africa, Kenya, Honduras, and other countries. Ten new cooperation agreements were signed with institutions including UNDP, UNOPS, and the Asian Development Bank, further consolidating and expanding global cooperation to advance GEI development. Over 20 capacity-building activities were carried out in Africa, Arab States, and Central and Latin America, training more than 5,000 participants. In collaboration with the UNFCCC Secretariat, GEIDCO established the Energy Cluster under the Paris Committee on Capacity-building (PCCB) Network—the first energy-sector capacity-building mechanism under the global climate action framework—contributing momentum and solutions to energy and power development in Global South countries.

**Advancing high-end international think tank development.** A series of high-quality research outcomes were released, including Digital and Intelligent Resilient Power Grids, Global Electricity Development and Transition 2025, Energy Interconnection Research and Outlook, and the Global Wind and Solar Power Generation Annual Forecast, providing innovative solutions for global energy transition. The English-language journal Global Energy Interconnection entered the SCI Q2 category in Electrical and Electronic Engineering, while the Chinese journal was indexed by EI, with its comprehensive energy discipline ranking rising to the top three in China, significantly enhancing academic influence.

**Advancing project implementation and standards development.** Focusing on practical needs and key areas of global energy transition, experts from over 10 countries and more than 200 specialists participated in standards development, leading to the successful release of the first batch of 11 Global Energy Interconnection international standards. These standards play a critical role in accelerating technological innovation, application, and energy interconnection. The List of Energy Transition for Biodiversity and GEI demonstration projects were also released, guiding broader participation in GEI development.

**Promoting organizational development and global outreach.** GEIDCO has established seven regional offices and 72 national representative offices worldwide, formed six regional committees and 20 national committees, and built a globally connected and highly efficient organizational framework. A value-oriented member service system has been put in place, with total membership reaching

1,450 organizations across 145 countries. More than 40 member engagement activities, including “Member Visits” and “Member Days,” were held throughout the year, and nearly 40 Chinese enterprises were organized to conduct exchanges and studies in Central Asia, South America, and Africa, continuously enhancing members’ sense of participation and benefit.

### Looking Ahead

The year 2026 marks the tenth anniversary of GEIDCO’s establishment and a critical year for accelerating GEI development and enhancing organizational capacity and global influence. As the global energy transition accelerates, clean, electrified, interconnected, and digitalized development has become the dominant trend. While the share of renewable energy in the global energy mix continues to rise, frequent large-scale power outages in many countries have underscored the importance of balancing energy transition with energy security. Practice has clearly demonstrated that large-scale development and utilization of clean energy, and the promotion of green, low-carbon, safe, and efficient energy systems, urgently require strengthened power grid development, interconnection, and mutual support. The concept and practical value of the Global Energy Interconnection are gaining increasingly broad and deep recognition, opening up even greater development prospects.

On the new journey ahead, GEIDCO will uphold the principles of extensive consultation, joint contribution, shared development, and win-win cooperation. With the goal of becoming a leading international organization of global voice, influence, and action, and defined by three core competencies—think tank, platform, and services—while embracing global, professional, and market-oriented development, GEIDCO will accelerate its transformation into a world-class international organization. We will continue to build a more cohesive international cooperation platform, a more influential high-end energy think tank, and a more value-creating service system for members and partners, injecting new momentum and making new contributions to global energy transition and sustainable development.

With the surging tides of spring, we move forward with confidence and determination. Let us work hand in hand to accelerate the development of the Global Energy Interconnection, allowing the light of green and low-carbon electricity to illuminate the world and jointly create a brighter future for the sustainable development of humankind.

I sincerely wish the Global Energy Interconnection endeavor continued success and new achievements. Wishing you all a Happy New Year, good health, success in your work, and happiness in your lives!

The Global Energy Interconnection Development and Cooperation Organization (GEIDCO) is a non-governmental, non-profit international entity that brings together companies, associations, institutions, and individuals committed to advancing sustainable energy development worldwide. Established in Beijing, China, on March 29, 2016, GEIDCO holds the distinction of being the first international organization in the energy sector initiated by China. Its mission is to promote the establishment of a Global Energy Interconnection (GEI) system that addresses global power demand through clean and sustainable energy solutions. GEIDCO has obtained consultative status with the UN Environment Programme and the United Nations Industrial Development Organization, and observer status at the UN Climate Change Conference and the UN Biodiversity Conference. Additionally, it has been recognized as a "National Advanced Social Organization" by the Ministry of Civil Affairs of China.

Members are an essential part of GEIDCO. As of the end of 2025, GEIDCO had pooled 1,450 members across 145 countries on five continents, representing 13 categories—including Energy and Power Enterprises, Equipment Manufacturing Enterprises, Project Construction Enterprises, Research Institutions, Universities and Colleges, and Organizations—thereby forming a comprehensive global cooperation network. GEIDCO's membership includes 35 Fortune Global 500 companies, internationally renowned institutions, and world-famous universities.

### High-end Matchmaking

GEIDCO will, in cooperation with institutions such as the Academy for International Business Officials of MOFCOM, the International Cooperation Center of National Development and Reform Commission, and the University of Chinese Academy of Social Sciences, invite international senior officials to visit its members, investigate new energy innovation demonstration projects, and participate in comprehensive, high-quality exchanges and training.

### Mechanism Cooperation

GEIDCO will partner with high-level platforms such as the World Economic Forum and the Multilateral Cooperation Center for Development Finance of AIIB to provide members with opportunities for resource matchmaking and thematic exchanges. Through collaboration across different mechanisms, GEIDCO will help members seize market opportunities and expand their business scope.

## Knowledge Product

### Data Resource

By mobilizing the intellectual resources of members and experts from the Advisory (Consultant) Board and Technical (Academic) Committee, GEIDCO will continuously launch knowledge products presenting significant theoretical research and innovative practice on energy interconnection. Examples include the periodic issuance of the International Energy and Electricity Bulletin and the Global Energy Interconnection Project Updates, and the publication of the Analysis Report on the Development and Hot Issues of China's Economy, Energy, and Power Sectors, all designed to support members' innovation and development.

### Professional Training

GEIDCO will establish a joint cultivation mechanism with its members and partners aligned with members' priority policy and technology areas. Through the mechanism, characteristic talent training will be carried out to support members in the capacity building of international and professional talent.

## Project Product

GEIDCO will mobilize resources to offer members one-stop project cooperation services, including project demonstration, investment guidance, liaison, and matchmaking in areas such as power grid interconnection, clean energy development, and low-carbon transition. It will select exemplary demonstration projects and training bases related to the GEI and new power systems and organize site visits and training activities for domestic and international members to explore new technologies, equipment, and products. In collaboration with relevant members, GEIDCO will promote the deployment of GEI demonstration projects and assist with project licensing, certification, and promotion.

## Planning the Series of "Member Records"

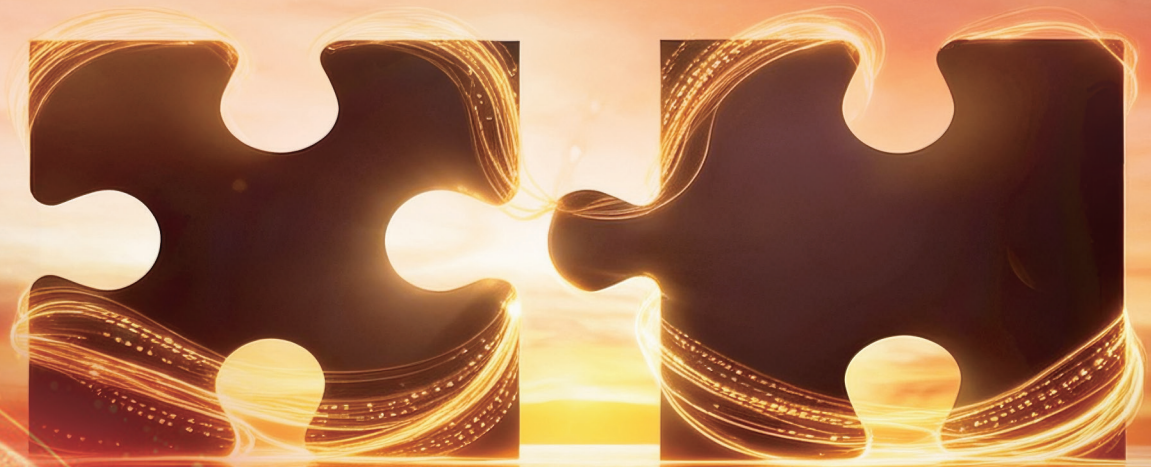
